evel 1 Class Description

This introductory course is designed for individuals with little to no prior knowledge of Spanish, or for those who need a refresher. The course focuses on building a solid foundation in the language, covering essential grammar, vocabulary, and pronunciation. Students will learn basic conversational skills.

***Note:** in-person classes will include additional conversation practice and activities the last 30 minutes of class.

- Nouns and adjectives
- Gender and number agreement
- "To be" ser and estar
- Numbers
- Dates, days of the week
- Telling time
- "There is, there are" hay
- Regular and irregular verbs in present tense

level 2 Class Description

This course builds on the foundational skills acquired in Spanish Level 1, helping students further develop their conversational abilities and understanding of basic grammar. Students will expand their vocabulary, practice more complex sentence structures, and gain confidence in communicating in various everyday situations.

*Note: in-person classes will include additional conversation practice and activities the last 30 minutes of class.

Key Topics

- Future tense using ir
- Time expressions with hacer
- Adjectives (possessive, comparative, superlative)
- Adverbs
- Forming negatives
- Object pronouns
- Preterit past tense
- Conversation and discussion

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evel 3 Class Description

This course builds on the skills acquired in Spanish Level 2, helping students further develop their conversational abilities and understanding of intermediate-level grammar. Students will expand their vocabulary, practice more complex sentence structures, and gain confidence in communicating in various everyday situations, relating stories, and discussing topics.

*Note: in-person classes will include additional conversation practice and activities the last 30 minutes of class.

Key Topics

- Past preterit regular verbs
- Past preterit irregular verbs
- Reflexive verbs
- Past imperfect tense
- Introduction to subjunctive
- Emphasis on conversation
- Short readings, videos

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evel 4 Class Description

This course places a strong emphasis on Spanish conversation and instruction. More advanced grammatical concepts are explored, and students will complete activities such as role-play, readings and stories, videos, and listening comprehension and discussion. Students will further develop their conversation skills, gain confidence in listening comprehension, and explore current events and cultural topics related to the Spanish-speaking world.

*Note: in-person classes will include additional conversation practice and activities the last 30 minutes of class.

Key Topics

- Subjunctive mood
- Imperative (commands)
- Complex verb tenses
- Strong conversational focus
- Short readings/stories
- Videos, audios
- Role-play
