

Spanish Immersion Trip: Conversation Prompts and Vocabulary

Your team is organizing a **Spanish immersion trip** for our ¡Hablemos! Conversation Group. Together, your team will plan the key details of the trip (in Spanish):

-  **Destination cities/areas** (Explain how to get there from Wichita, local transportation)
-  **Housing** (hotel, hostel, Airbnb, or homestay)
-  **Classes** (language school, workshops, cultural classes)
-  **Activities/excursions** (tours, museums, cultural sites, nature, beaches, etc.)
-  **Culture/language** (What cultural and language considerations are important to understand for this destination?)
-  **Food** (What typical dishes will the group try? Will we go to restaurants, cook ourselves?)
-  **Budget** (Estimate a reasonable price per person)

Prepare a short presentation (3-5 minutes) in **Spanish** to share your trip plan with the larger group. Feel free to research on your phone or with the library computers or books.

Use the following related vocabulary and phrases to help you. Beginners can keep it simple with key words and phrases. Intermediate/advanced speakers should add more details and creativity, and aim to present only *en español*.

Be ready to present your trip plan and answer questions from the group!

¿Qué necesitamos llevar? – What do we need to bring?

¿Por qué eligieron este destino? – Why did you choose this destination?

¿Qué actividades recomiendan? – What activities do you recommend?

¿Qué es lo más interesante de su viaje? – What is the most interesting thing about your trip?
